Serving over 60 caretakers, trappers, and pet households since October 2024 with a monthly pet food distribution. All volunteer, all by donation. We distribute nearly 1000 lbs of dry food and 900 cans of wet food monthly.

Wishlist

These items can be accepted in new condition. Except for canned food, we cannot accept open packages.

- Dry cat food, ideally 3-5 lb bags or 12-15 lb bags. All sizes welcome.
- Canned cat food, any type, partial cartons welcome.
- Dry dog food, ideally 3-5 lb bags or 12-15 lb bags. All sizes welcome.
- Canned dog food, any type welcome.
- Dental treats for cats and dogs
- Larger bags are useful for cat colonies that can number 40+ cats.
- Cat litter
- Paper bowls and plates, paper towels

We also accept, but please bring to our drop-off locations below

- Pet bedding, laundered
- Towels, sheets, blankets, laundered
- Pet dishes and bowls
- Leashes, collars, harnesses
- Crates, carriers, catios

Items can also be dropped off at our two locations

- 1440 Faulsey Way 15233 - this is a backyard address, a parking pad across from an empty field. Look for yellow #PghCatFolx yard signs and patio bins.
- 1213 W North Ave 15233 - steps. Leave items in bins on front porch.
